Message: Dear Joshua Basin Water District Directors, I am a customer in District Area 4, and I am deeply concerned with the August 5 agenda items 7a and 7b. No supporting documents exist for either item. Asking to censure a sitting director without giving the public any information cuts against the "Transparency" and "Accountability" values printed at the top of your agenda. It is unwritten, but the language of reorganization and placement directly above the censure suggests you are planning to strip Stacy Doolittle of her presidency. I don't believe you should. Your own minutes and agenda show her thinking is rigorous and independent. She asks the harder question; she is not a rubber-stamp vote. She's willing to be in the minority; she prioritizes being right rather than being comfortable. She's proactive, not reactive. Instead of just objecting to development pressure, she formed the Water & Growth Committee. She's outward-facing and heavily networked, consistently showing up at community association

meetings and even representing JBWD in regional water politics. She's kept serious ongoing issues like chromium-6 and Cadiz on the agenda. I approve of her strong leadership and style. We applaud that she doesn't back down to San Bernardino County. Her clarity, dedication, persistence and willingness to dissent is what I like about her leadership. If these are the same reasons you give for her dismissal, we have a problem. I am disappointed by whatever actions took place behind closed doors to form this agenda and ask the board to table both items until a written rationale is made public, and to reject any effort to remove President Doolittle from the presidency without one.
